Security

Over the weekend, Eulen foiled another attempt to break into properties inside the Club. They identified five intruders seeking entry at one of the known entry points. The guards attempted to intercept them but they fled in a car.

Of course, even if they had detained any of them before they had committed a burglary, the Guardia Civil would not have been able to take action anyway. This, however, is the second time in recent weeks that Eulen have prevented potential burglaries. Eulen believe that it was the same intruders on both occasions. The statistics for Cartagena show an increase in burglaries of 27% year on year. This means that not only has Eulen to step up its vigilance but also that owners have to ensure that their properties are secured.

We are currently in contract negotiations with Eulen where increased vigilance is a major discussion point. We would ask Presidents and Representatives to remind owners of their own responsibilities. Please ensure that all security measures are working e.g. alarms and security lights. Then turn on the alarms and set the security lighting to work when away from home. Also, do not leave accessible windows open. This is an invitation to potential burglars.

La Manga Club has a well-deserved reputation as an extremely secure resort. Ian Hunt, the Security Team Leader, Dennis French, his predecessor, and Pascual Sanchez have worked extremely hard to create this situation. It falls to all of us to keep it that way.
